English

Reading/Phonics – Children will attend daily Read Write Inc Phonics lessons and develop their comprehension skills every Monday.

Reading-We will be reading a range of stories set in familiar settings, traditional tales, poetry and non-fiction books. Including the following books: Bog Baby, Pingu The Dinosaurs Diary and Traction Man

Writing- We will be developing our spelling, grammar and punctuation skills to help our writing. We will be writing our own warning stories, recounts, stories with a familiar setting and instructions

Speaking and Listening-We will be developing our questioning skills to check understanding. We will have opportunities to describe, explain and talk about our understanding through each curriculum area.

Music

We will explore different genres of music through our Charanga scheme and explore pitch, pulse and rhythm through clapping, singing and movement. We will learn the song 'Hands, feet, Heart

Computing

We will learn to log on and explore our Purple Mash platform, including how to use algorithms to give instructions on a computer. We will be working with a Coding programme.

Science

We will learn about Animals, including humans. This winclude the life cycles of various animals and what they need to survive

Maths

We will be applying our basic understanding of number and place value to 20 including counting, sorting and comparing. We will be able to represent numbers to 20 in different ways. We will learn addition and subtraction including visual representations and number bonds and fact families. We will learn about and compare the properties of shapes,

We will be learning the medium of Dance and how we can dance will control and co-ordination

Art & Design

We will be learning about the formal elements of Art. We will be exploring patterns, texture and tone.
