Our children have settled in to school extermely well and all children have had their 'Protective Behaviours' curriculum delivered during the first few days of school. This scheme is critical to helping our children keep safe and understand who they can turn to for help and guidance.

Our children have also begun to experience our revised curriculum offer and have shown some great progress and engagement in the work that they have completed so far. Our staff have been working really hard to ensure they are delivering exciting and progressive lessons that support all our children to achieve their best. We are all working to ensure we deliver:

- a) Great teaching and learning for all;
- b) An engaging, well-planned curriculum and
- c) Ensure that everyone in our school community contributes effectively to school life.

We have also commenced the wide range of clubs that are on offer at school and these are already full to capacity – see the sports page for further information!


