This month we have welcomed several of our governors in to school to share our curriculum developments. They have found out about the work that our children have been completing and have also met with key subject leaders who have shared what we have been working on.

Our children have been enjoying the full range of clubs that we have on offer and our 'Peer Mediators' and 'Playground Pals' have been trained and are helping other children in play and conflict resolution – well done children!

Our teachers and teaching assistants have been receiving some great coaching and mentoring from our teaching and learning consultant to ensure our children get the very best teaching in school. Several of our staff are also working alongside our local Maths Hub – Origins Maths Hub - to develop their skill set in 'Mastery Mathematics' and will share this training with all staff in school.

Our Year 6 children have been taking part in our 'Into University' project where children are able to get a taste for university and help them to think about going to university as a route for them in the future. It is a fantastic opportunity which culminates in a visit to Warwick University.

It is not only our children who have been engaged in excellent learning this month. We have welcomed record numbers of parents and carers in to school to attend the range of training and information workshops that we have been running. Our wonderful Early Years and Phonics Lead – Mrs Dhesi – has been delivered phonics sessions for parents this month, supporting parents and carers with taking an active role in their children's early reading.

Additionally, our amazing Pastoral Lead – Mrs Ledbrooke - has been running workshops for parents on 'Keeping Safe Online' and helping our community understand the risks that exist for children when using a range of apps and the internet and to help parents safeguard their children at home.


