Herbert Art Gallery & Transport Museum – 21st September & 12th October 2026

During the Autumn Term in Year 6, the children will explore the history and geography of Coventry. They will learn how the city has changed over time, investigate its changing landscape, and discover the significant impact that the Second World War had on Coventry and its people.

To enhance their learning, we have two exciting educational visits planned.

On 21st September – Morning visit. Year 6 will visit the Herbert Art Gallery & Museum to take part in a workshop entitled Coventry Over Time. This half-day visit will provide the children with the opportunity to explore the city's rich history through a range of engaging activities. The children will walk to and from the venue during the school day. **Lunch will take place as usual in school.**

On 12th October, the children will take part in two further workshops: Coventry at War and Blackouts, Rationing and Evacuees. The children will walk to and from both venues (The Herbert Art Gallery and Coventry Transport Museum) during the school day. **If your child usually has a hot meal at school, then a packed lunch will be provided. Children who normally bring a packed lunch should do so as normal.**

Both trips will take place within the school day - 8.50am – 3.30pm.

The cost of the two trips is £13. Payment can be made via the MyChildAtSchool (MCAS) app or by paying the correct cash to the school office.
