

## English

**Reading/Phonics** – Children will attend daily Read Write Inc Phonics lessons and develop their comprehension skills every Monday.

**Reading**-We will be reading a range of stories set in familiar settings, traditional tales, poetry and non-fiction books. Including the following books: Toys in Space, Little Red Riding Hood and The Three Little Pigs.

**Writing**- We will be developing our spelling, grammar and punctuation skills to help our writing. We will be writing our own stories based on traditional tales and produce information texts.

**Speaking and Listening**-We will be developing our questioning skills to check understanding. We will have opportunities to describe, explain and talk about our understanding through each curriculum area.



## Music

We will explore different genres of music through our Charanga scheme and explore pitch, pulse and rhythm through clapping, singing and movement.

## Computing



We will learn to log on and explore our Purple Mash platform, including how to save our documents securely. Throughout all units we discuss the importance of online safety.

## Science

We will learn about the properties and uses of a range of materials. We will continue to explore the seasons and look at the changes through seasonal walks.

## Maths



We will be applying our basic understanding of number and place value to 20 including counting, sorting and comparing. We will be able to represent numbers to 20 in different ways. We will learn addition and subtraction including visual representations and number bonds and fact families. We will learn about and compare the properties of shapes.

## Art & Design

We will observe Contemporary and Abstract art and share how it makes us feel. Using different colour paints we will make shades of colour. We will repeat small designs (motifs) to make a repeating pattern and also experiment with different media.

# Curriculum Map

## Religious Education

In RE we will learn how and why faith is important to people with a particular focus on Christianity this term. This will include a visit to a Christian place of worship.



## PSHE - Jigsaw

During the first two weeks children will learn about Protective Behaviours to help them understand how to keep themselves safe. We will also look at the 'Jigsaw' PSHE scheme. The first topic is called 'Being Me in My World'.



## Physical Education

We will be doing PE with Mr Rogers on Friday mornings. PE will be taught outside as much as possible. Children will need to wear jogging bottoms, a t-shirt a sweatshirt and trainers on Fridays. Children will work on a variety of skills including core strength and balancing.



## Geography & History

We are learning about the weather and how it changes through the seasons. We will use simple observations to record and represent changes. We will be able to name some places in the world that are warm or cold and talk about the elements that make up the weather.
